YOUTH IN FOOD PROGRAM

The Youth In Food Program is a platform that connects job seekers with companies in the food and agriculture sector. We advocate and inspire young people to pursue a career in food. We do this by equipping youth with skills, resources and valuable connections: mentors like you!

Our third program runs from September 2023- February 2024.

GHANA FOOD MOVEMENT

Ghana Food Movement is a unique network of food change-makers. We connect people, businesses and organizations and inspire them to <u>take action</u> towards a more sustainable food system in Ghana and West Africa. One of our main objectives is to equip youth with the resources, skills and network to become change makers in the food space, one way to achieve this is our Youth In Food Program.

PROGRAM DETAILS

50 driven youth will get access to 6 months of inperson and online employability skills training. During this period we also organize a Food Career Fair where the job seekers get to connect with over 30 hiring companies in the food and agric sector.

On top of this, every selected job seeker will get connected to a mentor that will give them the personalised support needed to succeed in the food and agric job market. Mentors gives support throughout the job search: From tips on vacancies and networking to interview preparation and contract negotiation.

WHY MENTORSHIPS?

Our research shows that Ghanaian university graduates experience difficulties in landing relevant jobs due to lack of skills, network and resources. As a mentor you will have direct impact on eliminating some of these challenges and helping youth get jobs.

At the same time, the food and agric sector is not always seen as attractive. You are not only a coach but also a role model, showing example of an emerging, relevant and exciting sector.

WHAT DO WE EXPECT FROM YOU?

We want you to be passionate about supporting young people in their career and ready to spend 2-4 hours per week, supporting a group of 2-4 mentees from Sep 2023 to Feb 2024. Most of the mentoring will be done online, but we do require you to be available for the following dates in Accra:

- 26th of August 10- 2.30pm: Mentor training day with youth empowerment specialist
- 4th of Sep 2- 4pm: First day of youth skills training and introduction to mentors
- 16th of Sep: Food Career Fair
